1. How did the previous Partners in Ministry grant help you fulfill your mission/project/goals?

The Partners in Ministry (PIM) grant provides financial support for Sarah's staffing expenses. Sarah's staff maintains the home, making sure the physical, emotional, psychological and spiritual needs of the residents are cared for appropriately. PIM funding also provides financial support for approximately 1/3 of Sarah's remaining operational budget, including food, toiletries, bus passes and international calling cards for residents. Without PIM grant funding, Sarah's would not be able to fulfill its mission.

2. How will this grant help you fulfill your mission/project/goals? (Briefly Explain)

PIM grant funding is critical for Sarah's to maintain its operational budget, in particular, staffing. Without it, Sarah's would not be able to fulfill its mission. PIM funding continues to provide stability with the very necessary costs to Sarah's of food, toiletries, and transportation for Sarah's residents in particular those who have lost employment, new residents since May 2021 who still do not have work permits (new regulation in the previous presidential term was passed requiring a 365 day wait rather than the previous 150 day wait) and those who continue to work on the front lines in healthcare and grocery stores despite continuation of the pandemic. Additionally, Sarah's prior to the pandemic had received around \$30-40,000 a year in resident contributions towards expenses, during the pandemic when no new residents were accepted and stimulus payments / unemployment were possible this number was more like \$20,000, and since a number of residents with incomes moved on and new residents without work permits moved in, this number is now less than \$10,000. Being able to also provide support to those without employment (food, laundry soap, toiletries, clothing, international phone minutes, legal fees, education fees, healthcare fees, and transportation) continues to be an essential need with new residents not able to work for 365 days and PIM is essential to Sarah's to provide this needed support. Also of note, Sarah's had hosted a fundraiser for 5 years beginning Sarah's 20th anniversary year. This event was in-person and had staffing, venue, and food expenses associated with it the first four years. For the 25th anniversary, Sarah's hosted the event virtually and had the associated expenses of online production, videography, and printing mailings to celebrate that momentous year. However, non-anniversary years Sarah's is not planning on having an in-person or online annual event but rather shift to the more productive strategy of using the annual holiday appeal methods online and by mail that have resulted in increasing monthly donations from our regular donor group, "Friends of Sarah's." After July 1, 2022, instead of only having one annual appeal, Sarah's is instead going to have quarterly appeals. We are hoping that will result in a higher revenue from pass through giving and without the costs of hosting an event. This in combination with working together with Ministries Foundation staff to continue to develop and evaluate our strategies and platforms like Sarah's website are our focus and that also means that we are invested in having a successful Carondelet Celebration annual event. PIM continues to be essential with changing fundraising strategies and the challenges of fundraising during the pandemic.
