Program utilization...

- Capacity: 29
- Current residents: 29
- Lived at Sarah's between December 15th 2024 and February 15th 2025: 29

Employment...

- Found employment: 1
- Working full-time: 17
- Working part-time: 6
- Current residents without work permission/unable to work now (including people who CAN work but haven't found a job yet, also including people who are afraid to go to work currently due to ICE concerns): 7

Financial Independence (not including those in the EP, out of 25 people in regular program):

- Paying for their own groceries: 4
- Paying for their own phone bill: 6
 - *(and not being reimbursed)*
- Paying for their own bus passes: 4
- Can cover their own expenses *and* are contributing back to Sarah's (including loans): 5
