Program utilization...

- Capacity: 29
- Current residents: 29
- Lived at Sarah's between October 15th 2024 and December 15th 2024: 29

Employment...

- Found employment: 6
- Working full-time: 18
- Working part-time: 7
- Current residents without work permission/unable to work now (including people who can legally work but haven't found a job yet): 5

Financial Independence (not including those in the EP, out of 25 people in regular program):

- Paying for their own groceries: 6
- Paying for their own phone bill: 10
- Paying for their own bus passes: 6
- Can cover their own expenses *and* are contributing back to Sarah's (including loans): 6

Education...

- Current resident in college or work training classes (actively in classes now): 11
- Current resident in driving instruction classes (actively during this time period): 10
- Current resident who completed college or work training: 0
- Going to English classes: 8
 - All of these 8 are in the Friday class at Sarah's with LIS as well as attending Monday through Thursday classes elsewhere. They are all at beginning levels of English.

- Bus passes given out: 26
- Current resident who passed the written test and got their learner's permit: 1
- Current resident who passed the driving test and got their driver's license: 1

Permanent housing and Family reunification...

- Reunified with family: 0
- Moved into permanent housing: 0
